All of Calvary is invited to come to the Parish Hall, Wednesday, March 31 beginning at 5:30 pm to walk through Jesus' final days as a man on earth.

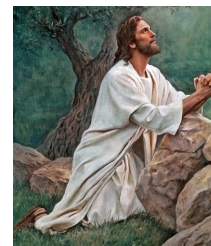
At each station, your senses are engaged through experience-focused activities that teach the events of Holy Week and Easter.
