Each circle sends one representative to a monthly business meeting to help plan projects, suggest mission projects, plan meals, etc. This meeting happens on the Third Thursday of each month at 7:00 PM. Deborah Circle

Deborah Circle meets the first Tuesday of the month at 7pm at one of our homes, September thru May. If it is at our house than we do the Bible study and serve dessert and coffee afterwards. Our Bible studies are family/woman oriented. We have been doing focus of the family studies the last few years. (The Bible studies usually are about an hour and half long. We are usually at circle for 2 to 2 1/2 hours.) We also have a prayer chain within our circle for prayer requests, and we have a prayer journal we do and update every month at circle or if we need a prayer before circle we either call each other or email the request. We do a mission project at least once a year. At Christmas we do a project, the last couple years we have given money to social ministry at Christmas time to help them. (We also have adopted a family in need at church or else where and give gifts and food. We have helped the Ronald McDonald house with supplies also.)

Martha Circle

Martha Circle meets the 3rd Tuesday of each month, except July and August, at 7:00 PM in homes of members. We have five members the oldest being 86 and the youngest 62. We use the Women's Quarterly for our Bible study. We have a structured meeting agenda. We use the Lutheran World Relief mission projects as our own. We also collect money in mites. Ruth Circle

Ruth Circle meets the third Tuesday of each month at 7 PM in the Parish Hall. We use the LWML Quarterly for our Bible study. Our mission projects include: Crittenton Center, Ronald McDonald House and the Gospel Mission. We have 17 members ranging in age from 30 to 70.



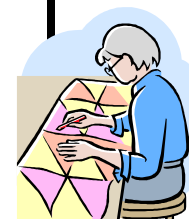
Calvary serves at the Soup Kitchen twice each year. Donations of non-perishable food are always welcome for our own food bank. Place donations by church office
